Important Information:

- It is recommended that you enroll in 12 – 15 units per term.
- The [Graduation Writing Requirement \(GWR\)](#) must be fulfilled before graduation by either enrolling in a GWR-certified, upper-division course OR by completing the GWR Portfolio (UNIV 4401). For more information on the GWR Portfolio, click [here](#).

- The [United States Cultural Pluralism \(USCP\)](#) requirement must be satisfied before graduation. USCP courses may double-count with a remaining GE requirement and are searchable on Schedule Builder.

Additional Notes, Tips, and More

- Always check course prerequisites to ensure eligibility to enroll.
- Complete remaining support courses as soon as possible.
- Students can double fulfill degree certain requirements. Double fulfilling occurs when one class satisfies two degree-requirements. ITP 3341 and ITP 3330 can be double counted with your GE Upper-Division 2/5 requirement.
- Check in with the Student Services Office at least once per term to ensure that you are on track towards degree completion
- BUS 1100: Career Readiness I. There are sections designed specifically for new Transfer Students. They focus on concentration exploration and addresses the unique experiences of newly admitted transfer students.
