The information systems concentration is open to business administration and economics majors.

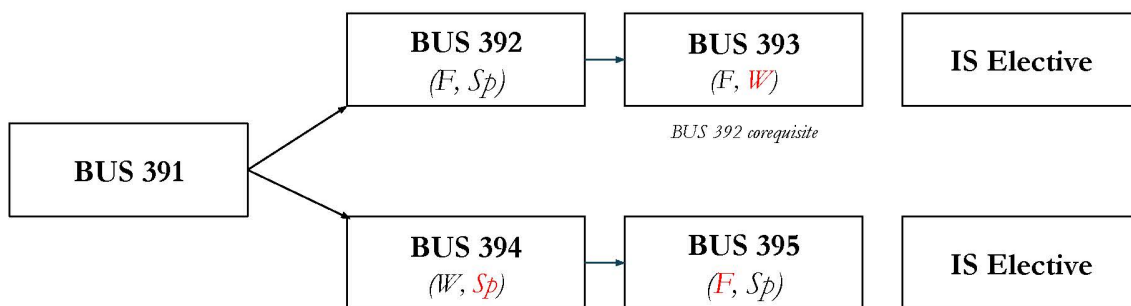
